CHARTER FEES:

420's: 420 class fees include the charter fee for use of a Club-owned 420. That fee also includes use of the boat in travel regattas during that student's session, and if available, in the PYC Regatta. If the student wishes to use the boat for any additional regattas, this may be done with the approval of the Program Director, with a \$250 damage deposit.

***OPTi's:** A limited number of OPTis are available for charter to previously approved students. Rates are \$65 for 2 weeks, \$150 for 4 weeks, and \$250 for 8 weeks. If not chartering, Opti sailors must provide their own boat. Charter fees include use of that boat in travel regattas during that student's session, and if available, in the PYC Regatta.

Plymouth Yacht Club Sailing Program Requirements 2020

The following list details forms and items that are required by the first day of class, in order to participate in our 2020 Summer program. (Documents are indicated in bold, underlined text within the details below.)

- A completed, signed copy of **Plymouth Yacht Club Junior Sailing Registration Form** and payment in full.

A fully completed PYC Junior Sailing Registration Form with parent/guardian signature indicating the understanding of liability and mandatory program requirements must be submitted.

➤ **Medical**

1. A completed **Plymouth Yacht Club Health Record Form** must be completed and submitted with your registration. This form will provide the Club with emergency names and numbers, a brief medical history, and medication and allergy information that may be important should a medical emergency arise for your child.
2. A photocopy of both sides of your **Medical Insurance Card** should accompany the registration form in order to expedite any emergency room care.
3. A standard **Physician's Health Certificate** signed by your child's physician must accompany the registration. Massachusetts requires that all children participating in summer recreational programs receive a recent physical examination and provide a doctor's certificate of good health. A standard medical form should be available from your doctor's office or school. This certificate is required and will be necessary for your child to sail. In 2020 that health certificate can be <18 months old.
4. A signed copy of our **2020 Covid-19 Waiver**. If your child is in a high-risk category for this disease, we highly recommend that he or she not be enrolled.

➤ **Swimming**

A swimming test will be administered to all students on the first day of their lessons, consisting of **50 yard swim with a lifejacket, and treading water for 3 minutes with a lifejacket.**

➤ **Equipment: Life Jackets – Whistle – Shoes – Face Covering**

All PYC sailors will be required to wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket with plastic whistle attached on a lanyard (string) while on the pier, in floats or in boats. Closed-toe, rubber-soled shoes, or non-skid shoes (boat shoes, sneakers or dinghy boots) are mandatory. No flip flops or Croc-type footwear are permitted. All sailors must also have a snugly-fitting fabric face covering to comply with current Covid-19 regulations.

➤ **Conduct**

PYC wants its junior sailors to develop their individual strengths, to improve their skills, and to have fun while doing so in a safe environment. In order to function well, the Program requires a high standard of commitment, effort and personal conduct from its sailors. Decent, self-respecting behavior and true sportsmanship are expected of all sailors while participating in the PYC Junior Sailing Program, on Club property, or representing PYC at outside regattas. Students who cannot abide by these expectations will given one warning and parent notification for the first infraction, and asked to leave the program if further infractions occur without refund of their remaining course fee.

➤ **Parent Orientation & Handbook**

Parent/Guardians must attend the Junior Sailing Program Zoom Orientation Meeting on **Monday, June 22, 2020, at 7:00 p.m.**, if their child is participating in the Junior Sailing Program. To summarize, the following are due by the first day of class, before your child may participate in our sailing program:

- Completed Registration Form
- Full Payment for Registered Class
- Plymouth Yacht Club Health Record Form
- Signed Physician's Health Certificate
- Photocopy of Medical Insurance Card
- Signed Covid-19 Waiver
- Signed Conduct Code/Discipline Agreement
